Based on this comprehensive consultation, a clear and decisive most majority of members have expressed the view that Thambraas should extend its support to the National Democratic Alliance (NDA) in the forthcoming elections in Thamilzhanadu, in which AIADMK and Bharatiya Janata Party are key constituents.
